

Instructions for boarding accommodation at MU dormitories for the academic year 2021 / 2022 - foreign students incl. students from the Slovak Republic - valid from August 31st, 2021

The following dates are announced for boarding:

September 9th, 2021 8:00 a.m.– 7:00 p.m.

September 10th, 2021 8:00 a.m.– 7:00 p.m.

September 11th, 2021 8:00 a.m.– 7:00 p.m.

September 12th, 2021 8:00 a.m.– 7:00 p.m.

In dormitories without a non-stop reception service, accommodation outside the designated boarding days is possible as follows:

dormitory Tvrdého, dormitory Klácelova, dormitory nám. Míru, dormitory Mánesova:

working days: 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. – person in charge of accommodation, 7:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m. - reception

Saturday + Sunday: 7:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m. - reception

If a student has a contract with an earlier start of the reservation than the declared main boarding dates, he or she enters under his or her accommodation agreement.

The student who duly entered into the Accommodation Contract and paid the reservation bail has a bed reserved until **September 30th, 2021**.

If the student **does not cancel** the reservation by September 30th, 2021 or **does not check in** on the above dates **without a written apology**, the accommodation contract expires and the booking bond is forfeited.

For all reservations, the accommodation fee is valid from the date of the agreed commencement of the accommodation contract.

Upon entering accommodation, the student is required to provide **proof of identity** (ID, passport), **ISIC card** (1st year students/exchange students can submit additional evidence to ISIC), fill in and sign **the registration card**, complete the **Electrical Device Application**, take **the form to take over the room, check the room**, any defects and deficiencies in this form and return it to the person in charge of accommodation or reception.

Bedding is not included in room amenities for hygiene reasons. Students can bring their own bedding or on arrival they can buy it at the dormitories, price 600 CZK (duvet, pillow, sheet, bed linen).

The foreign student also submits a Certificate of Full Vaccination - it is necessary to use Google translate in Chrome to get it in English

In addition, the student must prove before starting accommodation that:

- was fully vaccinated (14 days after the last dose),
- had a laboratory confirmed covid-19,
- had a maximum of 7 days of RT-PCR testing for SARS-CoV-2 virus, or no more than 72 hours of rapid antigenic test (RAT) for SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen testing negative,
- or a student undergoes a rapid antigenic test (RAT) on the spot to determine the presence of the SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen intended for self-testing (use by a non-professional person) or a rapid antigenic test supervised by a healthcare professional via an online service no later than 24 hours, tests are available for purchase at every reception.

The above must be demonstrated every 7 days (excluding vaccination and covid-19, which according to the measure is demonstrated only once before the start of accommodation).

**STUDENT HAS OBLIGATION TO INSERT CERTIFICATE ON VACCINATION AND RESULTS OF TESTS INTO IS MUNI!
IS MUNI APPLICATION FOR RECORDING OF CERTIFICATES WILL BE OPEN FROM AUGUST 31ST, 2021.**

If the student fails to prove the above, he or she is not allowed to enter the accommodation.

Conditions for accommodation after entering the Czech Republic:

The conditions for accommodation are adjusted according to the category of countries to which the relevant anti-epidemic measures are attached on arrival in the Czech Republic:

green category - before entering the territory of the Czech Republic or no later than 5 days after entry antigenic or PCR test

orange category - before entering the territory of the Czech Republic or no later than 5 days after entry antigenic or PCR test

red + dark red category - the obligation to take a PCR test on arrival in the Czech Republic at the earliest on Day 5, until then it is necessary to remain in self-isolation

black category - obligation to take a PCR test before arrival in the Czech Republic, after arrival in the Czech Republic to remain in self-isolation for 10 days ending with a negative PCR test

Testing and self-isolation conditions do not apply to persons who have at least 14 days after full vaccination or who have had Covid-19 disease in the last 180 days.

rules of self-isolation:

self-isolation means restricting free movement to the minimum strictly necessary, except for:

- a) paths needed to provide basic necessities and to provide childcare,**
- b) paths necessary to provide care for animals, use of necessary financial and postal services, refuelling**
- c) acute travel to medical facilities**
- e) travel to deal with urgent official business**
- f) funeral**
