

## Instructions for boarding accommodation at MU dormitories for the 2025/2026 academic year – valid from September 1, 2025

Checking in to the accommodation is possible from the agreed start of accommodation according to the accommodation contract.

Check-in is possible as follows:

- dormitory Vinařská – A1 – open from Monday, September 1, 2025 from 6 a.m.– reception available 24/7
- dormitory Vinařská – A2 – open from Monday, September 1, 2025 from 6 a.m.– reception available 24/7
- dormitory Vinařská – A3 – open from Monday, September 1, 2025 from 6 a.m.– reception available 24/7
- dormitory bří. Žůrků – open from Monday, September 1, 2025 from 6 a.m.– reception available 24/7
- dormitory Sladkého – open from Monday, September 1, 2025 from 6 a.m.– reception available 24/7

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- dormitory Tvrdého – open from Monday, September 1, 2025
  - dormitory Klácelova – open from Monday, September 1, 2025
  - dormitory nám. Míru – open from Monday September 1, 2025
  - dormitory Mánesova – open from Monday September 1, 2025

- check-in on working days: Monday – Friday: 8 a.m. – 3 p.m. – accommodation office

or reception

  - check-in on Saturday, September 13  
+ Sunday, September 14, 2025: 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. – accommodation office  
or reception

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If the student does not send a written notice in advance about their later arrival according to the accommodation contract, the accommodation contract will terminate, and the reservation deposit will be fully forfeited.

For all reservations, the accommodation fee is valid from the agreed start date of accommodation as per the accommodation contract.

Accommodation contracts are signed electronically, and date changes (later than the start of the reservation) are not possible.

Acceptance of signed accommodation contracts by the accommodation provider will be done on September 1, 2025.

Upon check-in, the student is required to provide **proof of identity** (ID, passport), **ISIC card**, fill in and sign **the registration card**, complete the **Electrical Device Application form**, take **the Room Condition Report form**, **check the room**, write down any defects and deficiencies into this form, and return it to the accommodation assistant or reception.

Bedding is not included in the room amenities for hygiene reasons. Students can bring their own bedding, or they can buy it at the dormitories upon their arrival for CZK 850 (duvet, pillow, sheet, bed linen).

Students must bring all the kitchen equipment (pots, plates, cutlery, etc.) themselves.
